The minutes of the regular meeting on February 11, 2020.

PRESENT WERE JON HOFSTETTER, SCOTT WIDMER, TOM GREGORY; AND FISCAL OFFICER ANITA FISHER

- Jon Hofstetter called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.
- A motion to approve January 14, 2020 regular meeting minutes was made by Jon Hofstetter and seconded by Scott Widmer.
 Motion carried.
- A motion to approve the January 23, 2020 special meeting minutes as amended was made by Tom Gregory and seconded by Scott Widmer. Motion carried
- The Fiscal Officer presented the January 2020 Financial Reports. Jon Hofstetter made a motion to approve the financial reports for January 2020 as presented. Tom Gregory seconded. Motion carried.
- The Fiscal Officer presented the bank reconciliation from January 2020 for review. Jon Hofstetter made a motion to approve the January 2020 bank statement and reconciliation with Scott Widmer seconding. Motion carried.
- Payroll vouchers for road employees Kevin Hofstetter and Scott Feltis were signed by the trustees.
- Fiscal Officer presented the Amended Certificate of Estimated Resources as of 12/31/19 for review.
- Fiscal Officer presented the Township Annual Permanent Appropriation Resolution for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2020 for review and approval. Jon Hofstetter made a motion to approve and adopt Permanent Appropriation Resolution 2020-02-12-01 to provide for the current expenses and other expenditures during the fiscal year ending December 31, 2020. Scott Widmer seconded.

A roll call vote was taken.

Motion carried.

- The Fiscal officer presented then and now purchase orders #28-2020 through #38-2020 for a total of \$6,837.17. Jon Hofstetter moved to approve then and now purchase orders and Tom Gregory seconded. Motion carried.
- The Fiscal officer presented the payment listing for bills to be paid including #16-2020 through #27-2020 and #22016 thru #22040 for a total of \$21,667.24. Jon Hofstetter moved to approve the bills to be paid for February 2020 and Scott Widmer seconded. Motion carried. See attached (A).
- Fiscal Officer presented an updated Fund Balance for February 2020. See attached (B).
- Jon Hofstetter gave an update regarding several old business items such as an update on Ohio Township Association Risk Management (OTARMA) and the information we are asking of them which includes what other townships are doing, as well as an update from the Wayne County Prosecutor. Per the road supervisor Kevin Hofstetter, he would like to see the safety inspection happen around June. Tom Gregory will be the administrator for the online courses with OTARMA. Jon Hofstetter also mentioned moving forward with a township handbook, with resources from OTARMA in conjunction with the Wayne County Prosecutor. Jon Hofstetter made a motion to approve resolution 2020-02-11-02 to make Jon Hofstetter the point of contact with the Wayne County Prosecutor in regards to creating and adopting a township handbook. Tom Gregory seconded.

A roll call vote was taken.

Jon Hofstetter - Yes

Motion carried.

Also, OTARMA is open to reviewing the Kidron Volunteer Fire Department (KVFD) East Wayne Fire District (EWFD) contracts and give suggestions if needed.

Jon Hofstetter gave an update on EWFD and the settlement contract. Scott Widmer mentioned not seeing any of the recommendations from the Wayne County Prosecutor incorporated into the contract, and several other items that are incorrect. It was mentioned that we are discussing things that are in the past that actually were incorrect and didn't happen that way. Tom Gregory asked why we would be wanting to amend the five-year contract and not just move forward. The EWFD agreement for fire services appears to be similar to the KVFD agreement except that they are wanting a five-year agreement versus a one-year contract, which would not correspond to any levy. Per Jon Hofstetter the longer contract is showing commitment from the board to work with EWFD. Another item to note is that the documents left out any discussion of the area covered by Orrville. It was discussed that we currently don't have a contract with Orrville due to some comments that were made regarding the dispatching. Tom Gregory mentioned that our goal should be to get this settlement done as soon as possible and thinks that the board needs to be unified in order for future levies to be successful. Tom Gregory also thinks we need to get away from the wording "five-year contract" due to the connotations with that. Each trustee will review the documents and highlight issues and questions for the Wayne County Prosecutor. The Fiscal Officer mentioned the importance of this settlement and discussions to be an "arm's length transaction".

- Future capital purchases were discussed as well as which tractor to purchase based upon the recommendation of the road supervisor. The two tractors are being looked at. Key components are getting the features that are needed, the after the sale service available and being able to pay cash and not finance anything. Jon Hofstetter made a motion to authorize road supervisor Kevin Hofstetter to purchase a 2020 CASE Tractor for \$98,568. Scott Widmer seconded. Motion carried. Jon Hofstetter also made a motion to authorize the road supervisor to purchase a 2020 Alamo Maverick2 Telescopic Boom Mower in the amount of \$78,122 along with an Alamo 48" Flail-Axe Cutting Head for \$16,743 and an Alamo Ditcher Head for \$13,612. Scott Widmer seconded. Motion carried. See attached (C).
- Road supervisor Kevin Hofstetter is working on getting tree trimming quotes. Jon Hofstetter made a motion to authorize Road Supervisor Kevin Hofstetter to obtain a minimum of two tree trimming quotes and pick the best service for the best price. Bidder must show proof of liability insurance, not to exceed \$9,000. Scott Widmer seconded. Motion carried.
- Road supervisor Kevin Hofstetter is also obtaining quotes on a fence that would enclose the area behind the garage and salt shed.
 Jon Hofstetter made a motion to authorize Kevin Hofstetter to contract to install the fence without barbed wire. Scott Widmer seconded. Motion carried. See attached (D).
- Road supervisor Kevin Hofstetter is looking to change out some light bulbs in the garage. A lift will be rented from General Rent-All to assist with the project for safety purposes. Jon Hofstetter made a motion to purchase the new lightbulbs for \$1,188, plus the rental of a lift. Tom Gregory seconded. Motion carried. See attached (E).
- Road supervisor Kevin Hofstetter is looking to purchase a post driver. Jon Hofstetter made a motion to authorize Road Supervisor Kevin Hofstetter to purchase a post driver and accessories not to exceed \$3,006. Scott Widmer seconded. Motion carried. See attached (F).
- Jon Hofstetter provided the road supervisor's report for January 2020. See attached (G).
- An update has been sent to the Wayne County Engineers office concerning the date, time, and location of our meetings.
- Jon Hofstetter took a class at the Ohio Township Association (OTA) regarding parliamentary procedures, such as letting the public know how the township will handle the meetings. Work will continue on this.
- The contract to retain Attorney Alfred E. Schrader for calendar year 2020 was discussed. The Wayne County Prosecutor will work
 in conjunction with Attorney Schrader when they can as well. Jon Hofstetter will follow up with Attorney Schrader regarding
 amendments to the contract to retain him as well as a fee schedule.
- Jon Hofstetter spoke to the Wayne County Auditor Jarra Underwood regarding why our revenues were less for 2019 than we had anticipated. There were a variety of reasons as to why this has happened such as homeowners refiling for updated values, delinquencies, new buildings being classified as tax exempt, etc. The revenue budget appears to be slightly overstated.
- Tom Gregory gave an update on the WENS systems. He will be meeting with Joe Villeagas to review how to use the system. He gave an update on a seminar he attended at the OTA conference regarding how to prepare for a disaster before it happens as well as what we should be doing and what our role is. We may want to adopt the Wayne County emergency plan to fulfil the ORC requirement to have an emergency plan in place. Tom Gregory will follow up with this.

- Jon Hofstetter reviewed the information regarding the PUCO electric aggregation renewal information. Tom Gregory will do further investigation regarding this matter.
- Discussion was had on future tax levies and whether the township wants to create a fire tax district in the unincorporated portion of the township. Scott Widmer will do further work on this matter.
- Discussion was had on the records still with Reed Records and setting a time to meet again. Jon Hofstetter will contact Reed Records with our plan to move forward.
- Jon Hofstetter mentioned some website improvements that have been made. Possible additional changes were discussed. Jon Hofstetter will continue working on this. He also gave an update from OTARMA regarding our technology policies and work that may be done in this area.
- Jon Hofstetter discussed information from the Board of Elections regarding whether anyone on the board could help with the election if needed. Jon Hofstetter and Tom Gregory will be available to help.
- Jon Hofstetter discussed information received regarding the upcoming census. Jon Hofstetter will look into this further.
- The new rates for Armstrong Cable were reviewed. Telephone rates will not increase. See attached (H).
- Fiscal Officer presented a UAN report that will be given to the Road Supervisor to assist with his planning.
- Next meeting will be March 10th at Das Dutch Kitchen in the Cottage at 7:00 p.m.
- Jon Hofstetter made a motion to adjourn at 9:19 p.m. Scott Widmer seconded. Motion carried.
